How does the program work?

- 15 weeks, January through May – 2 hours per weekly session

- Each student team presents their final project at the last session
- Panel of judges to evaluate and select winning project
- Selected team will present their project at the Bay Area Affiliate Event

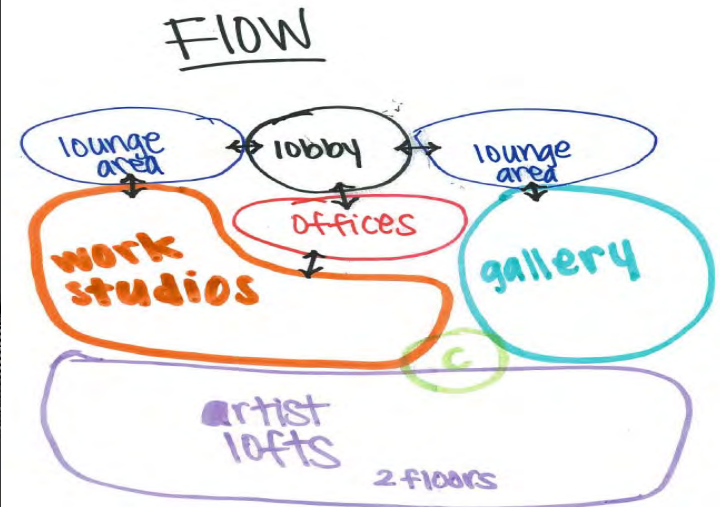
SF TEAM 1: 2014

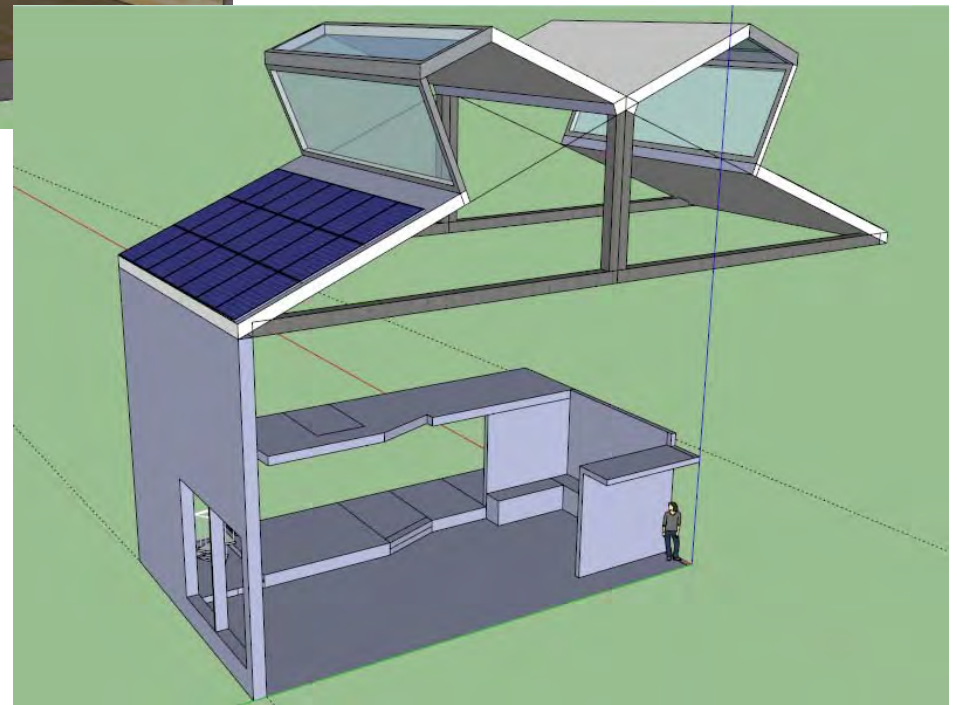

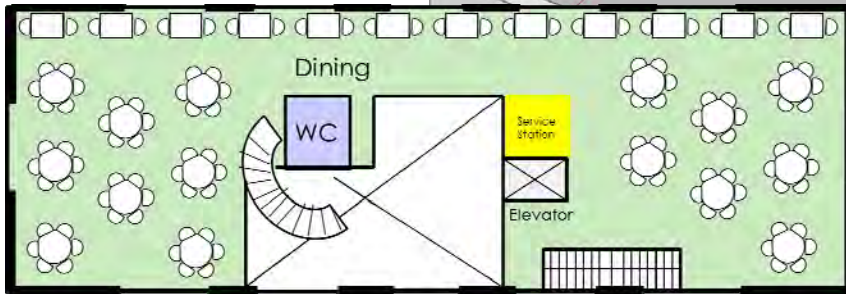
